**Official announcement for the conferral of 1 total fee exemption in the amount of € 16.500 and for the conferral of student housing and lunch service scholarship, for citizens from non high-income countries (low income countries or lower middle income or upper middle income countries) enrolled in the**

Scholarships are announced and awarded by the Executive Committee of the University in compliance with legislation safeguarding university self-governance and the right to study.

The UNISG student apartments may feature double rooms and mixed gender.

The lunch service at the Academic Tables Dining Hall is only included on days in which academic activities are scheduled. Student Housing, hospitality is guaranteed until the end of the lessons.

#### **ART. 1 – ELIGIBILITY**

Citizens from low income countries or lower middle income or upper middle income can apply for the total scholarship if they meet the following requirements:

- be in possession of a **minimum level of English language equivalent to a C1-level**, (in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). The candidate must complete an online interview with a UNISG professor (use of the webcam required) in order to verify the aforementioned minimum English language requirement;



- income and property situation does not exceed the limits indicated above;
- have been admitted to the Master program for the 2022/2023 academic year with a minimum score of **80/100**;
- be subsequently enrolled as a regular student in the program (auditors are not eligible to apply).

## **ART. 2 – INELIGIBILITY AND EXCLUSION**

Students may not apply for a fee exemption if,

- they are not regularly enrolled for the academic year for which they are applying for exemption;
- their application arrives after the stated deadline (Art. 3);
- they have not provided the required documentation (Attachments 1);
- a family member has already been assigned a UNISG fee exemption;
- they have already obtained academic qualifications that are equivalent to or higher than the One-year 1<sup>st</sup> level Master Degree.

## **ART. 3 – DEADLINES AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

The complete required documentation (see Attachments 1) must arrive by **October 28, 2022** and submitted by email to the following address: [segreteria@unisg.it](mailto:segreteria@unisg.it). Please indicate in the object of the email “*Scholarship application, a.y. 2022/2023 – Name of the Master program*”. Documents must be sent readable and in pdf or word format.

Late delivery of documents will not be accepted. Candidates are invited to contact the Registrar Office in the event they have not received a confirmation email within 3 business days following the document submission. UNISG reserves the right to require the original documentation at any given moment.

## **ART. 4 – ANNOUNCEMENT OF SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES**

Fee exemptions are awarded based on the student’s merit status. Should two candidates have the same score, the one from the lower income group will be awarded the university fee exemption. Should both come from the same income group, the fee exemption will be assigned to the candidate with the higher Interview score.

The final list of students awarded fee exemptions will be published on the university’s website ([www.unisg.it](http://www.unisg.it)) by **November 11, 2022**.

## **ART. 5 – ALLOCATION OF FEE EXEMPTIONS**

No sums are allocated directly to fee exemption holders. Fee exemption holders are exempt from paying university fees for the amount granted. The exemption is granted after the merit requirements (Attachment 3, Merit Requirements Renewal) are verified. The assignment of a place in student housing and access to the university dining hall does not entitle the student to convert these benefits into cash values owed. In the event that a student loses his/her entitlement to a scholarship, the student will receive



written notification of the same.

## **ART. 6 – ASSESSMENT OF SELF-DECLARATIONS**

### **Assessment of financial conditions**

The University may attempt to independently verify the truthfulness of all documentation submitted by applicants, even after the fee exemption has been granted. To this end, the University may solicit additional documentation.

### **Penalties**

Students found to have submitted false information and/or documentation in order to obtain a fee exemption will lose their right to such benefits<sup>2</sup>, as well as any future possibility for university fee exemptions. Criminal cases may be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

### **Handling of personal data**

Upon submitting their signed self-declaration form, students are informed of European law, Reg.(UE) 2016/679, and Italian legislative Decree n. 196 of 30 June 2003, and subsequent amendments and additions, as well as the provisions of the authority that guarantees protection of personal data.

Students' personal data, which must be provided for the purposes of determining eligibility and assigning scholarships, are processed exclusively for the purposes of managing this announcement and are stored at the University of Gastronomic Sciences – Academic and Registrar Office, with corresponding records kept in digital format. Students who fail to provide said data cannot be evaluated and will therefore be excluded from the process.

As per the above mentioned Legislative Decree, candidates may exercise their right to correct, update, complete or erase inaccurate or incomplete data or data collected in violation of current privacy laws.
